Green lit: Gekko's new george ring light saves power with keyframe

Gekko Technology: keyframe intelligent interface — which minimises the power used by Gekko's already frugal LED lights by syncing the light to the camera shutter, so that the light is off when the shutter passes the sensor. The keyframe can reduce power requirements by as much as 40% (from 28W to just 17W), extending battery power appreciably. It works “without the annoying flicker or movement artefacts that have plagued previous sync-strobe lighting systems and without compromising any functionality,” claimed Gekko's owner, David Amphlett. Users can still do any sector switching or dimming that they would normally do on the ring lights.
